

Alert: Recall of Tomatoes Due to Possible Contamination of Salmonella

To Our Valued Customer Partners,

This is to advise you that Pacific Coast Fresh Company is **NOT** involved with the recent recall of tomatoes due to possible contamination with salmonella. Below is the information issued from the recalling firm, with FDA knowledge:

This is to inform you of a product recall involving: Tomatoes, H&C 5x6 25lb, H&C 6x6 25lb and Williams Farms Repack LLC 4x4 2layer, 4x5 2layer, 60ct 2layer, 60ct 18lb loose (2layer box), XL loose (2layer Box), and 14-3ct trays in a 25lb box. Lots R4467 and R4470.

This recall has been initiated due to a possible contamination of salmonella from its original Shipper H & C Farms. The product began shipping on 4/23/25. Immediately examine your inventory and quarantine product subject to recall. In addition, if you have further distributed this product, please identify your customers and notify them at once of this product recall. Your notification to your customers may be enhanced by including a copy of this recall notification letter.

Remove Product. Notify distribution centers and retailers to remove affected items from store shelves and inventory. It is imperative that the recalled product is returned to the wholesaler for safe and responsible disposal.

This Recall should be carried out at the wholesale, retail, consumer, or user level.

This recall is being made with the knowledge of the Food and Drug Administration. As of this notice, the FDA has not posted any information concerning this recall.
